Topic - Benefits of Completion

Skills that would develop our character such as planning, problem solving, communicating effectively, scheduling and readjusting cannot be achieved if we are constantly abandoning our goals, visions, and dreams.

◆ Point 1 ~ Effective Communication

- It is important to express what is in your mind and heart.
- It can be difficult to tie what you hear and believe to its execution.
- Communicating with God first, is the foundation in being able to communicate effectively with others.

◆ Point 2 ~ Evaluating Your Plan

- God has a plan for us.
- His plans are to prosper us and not harm us. To give us hope and a future.
- In our private prayer we need to ask God to help us align the plans we have with the the plans He has for us.
- God gives us the ok to ask what we will. There is no harm in asking God to direct us through the plan He has for us.

◆ Point 3 ~ Remember Plans Change

- Once you have a specific goal and have planned out the steps to get there, you are not guaranteed immediate success.
- Unexpected factors will cause a hiccup in your journey.
- There will be problems to solve and plans to readjust. You may get discouraged but don't stay discouraged.
- Reflect, pray, meditate and readjust. Then continue the journey.

Additional Points

- It's important to keep our minds open to adjustments.
- If we're going to be led by the Holy Spirit, then we must understand that it has a direction that may be different from ours.
- The Holy Spirit is the guide.
