Topic - Finish What You Started

This is the introduction to our 3-part teaching series on the importance of completing the things that we have started.

◆ **Point 1 ~ We must understand that God gives us everything we need to get the job done.**

- God will supply us with wisdom, knowledge, strength, self control etc.
- Spiritual abundance will empower us to carry out physical objectives. But let's remember it's according to His riches.

◆ **Point 2 ~ We must always remember who we are.**

- Our identity is directly related to how we carry out the vision that God has given each of us. And I put emphasis on each of us.
- Remember what God told you to do. He wants you to understand that you are fearfully and wonderfully made. You are made in His image and in His likeness. That He has a plan for you. Comparisons are not good. He knows who you are even before you were formed in your mother's womb.
- No situation or life circumstances can cause you to be removed from his hand . Not only does He hold you in His hand , He uplifts you. You are just the one to carry out and fulfill the goal He has place before you.

◆ **Point 3 ~ Time is a gift from God**

- When we treat it as such, we can maximize its usage.
- When we understand that God's time is different from our own and that God gives us new mercy and grace every day. Then we can understand that we don't have to become anxious or nervous about getting something done.
- We have the power to adjust time according to what our other commitments are.
- When we don't overcommit ourselves and understand the value of our own time, time will become our friend.
- Let's use time to our spiritual advantage.
