◆ **Point 1 ~ Obedience**

◆ **Point 2 ~ Trust**

- We must trust the Spirit.
- The minor adjustments, small realignment, resetting time frames cause a significant change in our behavior and character development.
- We are more focused, more peaceful, and more self directed.
- We are clear to what our assignment is. We are truly being spirit lead, and are beginning to see small manifestations of what God has promised us.

◆ **Point 3 ~ Alignment**

- We have crafted schedules that align closely to our own daily operations.
- We are becoming comfortable with not aligning ourselves with social trends or worldly standards.
- We read, we pray we journal, we exercise we fast based on the constructs of our daily schedule.
- We don't see a shifting of our schedule as a major crisis, but a minor adjustment to fulfill God's purpose.

◆ **Point 4 ~ Don't be Afraid**

- Jesus is with us every step of the way, giving us understanding, knowledge, and as much wisdom as we ask for.
